Call the parish office and make an appointment with one of the parish priests for the required preparations and to set the wedding date. Ordinarily preparations will take at least six months.

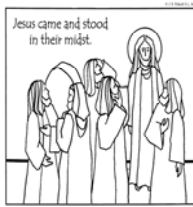
## QUINCEAÑERAS

**FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR:**



St. John's gospel begins by telling us that the apostles were frightened and had gathered, in an upper room with locked doors. There is an element of fear and anguish. How do you think Peter and his friends felt having deserted and denied Jesus during his Passion? ... It must have been a pretty tense and embarrassing moment....Jesus breaks into the story slowly.

The Resurrection and the outpouring of the Holy Spirit both take place on 'the first day of the week.' Jesus appears in the room and gently offers them peace. The Risen Jesus 'breathed on them' as he conferred the gift of the Holy Spirit.

The book of Genesis recounts the story of creation, where the breath of God is described as a life-force that hovered over the waters of the primordial chaos. In the scene described in the Gospel today, that same breath of God comes upon the interior chaos of frightened disciples hiding out in the upper room. There is certainly excitement, relief, joy, and tears of conciliation and understanding as the miracle continues to unfold and make sense. Jesus breathes new life into them and brings 'shalom', peace, upon them and all the earth. Thomas answered and said, 'My lord and My God'

He commissioned the Apostles to go out and tell the story of His resurrection and the Good news he brought to the world. Many people believed the words, signs, and wonders of Jesus' followers. Together they broke bread, prayed, shared faith filled stories and supported one another. Many sold their possessions and used the proceeds to help the less fortunate.

As the concluding words of today's Gospel indicate, this story is told for us, to bring us to faith in Jesus as Risen Lord so that "through this belief you may life in his name".

And guess what, unbelievably, there was this subtle and a dramatic change brought about in them: these weak men turned into passionate preachers, teachers, healers and martyrs for their Lord.

**EASTER SEASON - PENTECOST**

We have from now until Pentecost to celebrate different aspects of the Paschal mystery. It is amazing to find how much more there is to learn about our faith and our liturgy. We embark upon a faith filled journey to celebrate God's love for us and our love for God and our hope in his promises. There are obvious differences in worship during this Easter season. The Church presents the Easter Candle lit in the sanctuary, (New candle lit from the new fire blessed at Easter Vigil), the priests and deacons vest in white throughout this season to resemble the newness that Jesus has brought about in our lives. The first reading, which almost always is taken from the Old Testament for the rest of the year, comes from the New Testament, from the Acts of the Apostles. The Church directs us to reflect on the beginnings of the Early Church, through 'Acts of the Apostles'.

**Reflexiones del Párroco:**



El Evangelio de San Juan comienza diciéndonos que los apóstoles estaban asustados y se habían reunido, en una habitación superior con las puertas cerradas. Hay un elemento de temor y angustia. ¿Cómo creen que Pedro y sus amigos se sentían al haber abandonado y negado a Jesús durante su pasión? ... Debe haber sido un momento bastante tenso y vergonzoso .... Jesús comunica la historia lentamente. La Resurrección y la efusión del Espíritu Santo ambos toman lugar en 'el primer día de la semana'. Jesús aparece en la habitación y suavemente les ofrece paz. El Jesús resucitado "sopló sobre ellos" conforme confirió el don del Espíritu Santo.

El libro de Génesis relata la historia de la creación, donde el aliento de Dios es descrito como una fuerza vital que sobrevoló las aguas del caos primordial. En la escena descrita en el Evangelio de hoy, ese mismo aliento de Dios viene sobre el caos interior de discípulos asustados escondidos en la sala superior. Ciertamente hay emoción, alivio, alegría y lágrimas de conciliación y comprensión conforme el milagro continúa a revelarse y tener sentido. Jesús respira nueva vida en ellos y le trae "shalom", paz, a ellos y a toda la tierra. Tomás respondió y dijo: "Señor mío y Dios mío "

Él le encargó a los Apóstoles salir y contar la historia de Su Resurrección y la Buena nueva que trajo al mundo. Mucha gente creyó las palabras, señales y maravillas de los seguidores de Jesús. Juntos partieron el pan, oraron, compartieron historias llenas de fe y se apoyaron mutuamente. Muchos vendieron sus posesiones y utilizaron las ganancias para ayudar a los menos afortunados.

Como indican las palabras finales del Evangelio de hoy, esta historia es narrada para nosotros, para traernos a la fe en Jesús como Señor Resucitado para que "a través de esta creencia tengamos vida en su nombre".

Y adivina que, increíblemente, hubo este sutil y dramático cambio provocado en ellos: estos hombres débiles se convirtieron en predicadores apasionados, maestros, curanderos y mártires para su Señor.

**TEMPORADA DE PASCUA - PENTECOSTÉS**

Tenemos desde ahora hasta Pentecostés para celebrar diferentes aspectos del misterio Pascual. Es sorprendente encontrar cuánto más hay que aprender acerca de nuestra fe y nuestra liturgia. Embarcarnos en una jornada llena de fe para celebrar el amor de Dios por nosotros y nuestro amor por Dios y nuestra esperanza en sus promesas.

Hay diferencias obvias en el culto durante esta temporada de Pascua. La iglesia presenta la vela de Pascua iluminada en el santuario, (Nueva vela encendida del fuego nuevo bendecido en la Vigilia de Pascua), los sacerdotes y diáconos visten en blanco a lo largo de esta temporada para dar símbolo a lo nuevo que Jesús ha traído en nuestras vidas. La primera lectura, que casi siempre es tomada del Antiguo Testamento por el resto del año, viene del Nuevo Testamento, de los Hechos de los Apóstoles. La Iglesia nos dirige a reflexionar sobre el comienzo de la Iglesia Antigua, a través de los "Hechos de los Apóstoles".



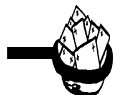
