MINISTRY TO THE SICK & HOMEBOUND

Call the parish office to make arrangements to administer this sacrament for one who is sick or homebound or in the hospital. The Parish Priests visit the sick & homebound and administer the Holy Eucharist, the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the sacrament of the sick on the First Friday of the month. Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist bring Holy Communion to the sick and homebound on weekends.

MARRIAGE

Call the parish office and make an appointment with one of the parish priests for the required preparations and to set the wedding date. Ordinarily preparations will take at least six months.

MATRIMONIO

QUINCEAÑERAS

Call one of the parish priests to make an appointment to set the quinceañera date. The quinceañera is expected to have received all three Sacraments of initiation. Baptism, Holy Communion and Confirmation. The family is expected to be registered and worship in the parish. Preparations will take at least six months.

The Acts of the Apostles reflects on the death of Jesus as a redemptive act of the Suffering servant foretold by Isaiah, rather than as a tragic accident or horrific mistake. God brought to fulfillment what the prophets announced long ago: that the Messiah would suffer.

John writes saying that Jesus is the intercessor who offers sacrifice for the sins of the world. The death of Jesus is salvation for all humanity, who believes in his name. It is the life in the Risen Christ that endures forever.

The Risen Christ appeared to the disciples and said: "Peace be with you.". The lord ate cooked/ baked fish in their presence and discussed the Law, Prophets and Psalms with them, challenging them to open their minds to receive and understand the Scriptures.

This passage from the end of the Gospel of St. Luke has made an immeasurable contribution to the sacramental theology and to the celebration of the Eucharist. The Gospel passage is incredibly moving and thought provoking. The text has a strong narrative progression, a clear beginning and ending. Exchanges are employed to simply advance the action. It is Jesus who takes the initiative: He recognizes their troubled souls with questions in their hearts... It is his pierced hands and feet, and the Gospel says: "***they were incredulous for joy and were amazed***". And Jesus says: "***You are witnesses of these things***".

the Blessed Sacrament



TERCER DOMINGO DE PASCUA

22 DE ABRIL DEL 2012

Reflexiones del Párroco:

Los Hechos de los Apóstoles reflexiona sobre la muerte de Jesús como un acto Redentor del sufrimiento del siervo anunciado por Isaías, en lugar de como un trágico accidente o un error terrible. Dios trajo al cumplimiento lo que los profetas anunciaron hace tiempo: que el Mesías sufriría.

Juan escribe diciendo que Jesús es el intercesor que ofrece sacrificio por los pecados del mundo. La muerte de Jesús es salvación para toda la humanidad, que cree en su nombre. Es la vida en el Cristo resucitado que perdura para siempre.

El Cristo Resucitado se apareció a sus discípulos y dijo: "La paz este con ustedes.". El señor comió pescado cocido en su presencia y discutió la ley, los profetas y salmos con ellos, abriendo sus mentes para entender las Escrituras.

Este pasaje del final del Evangelio de San Lucas ha hecho una contribución incalculable a la teología sacramental y a la celebración de la Eucaristía. El pasaje del Evangelio es increíblemente conmovedor y estimulante. El texto tiene una fuerte progresión narrativa, un principio y final claro. Los intercambios se emplean para simplemente hacer avanzar la acción. Es Jesús quien toma la iniciativa: Él reconoce sus almas agitadas con preguntas en sus corazones... Son sus manos y pies perforados, y el Evangelio dice: "*estaban incrédulos de alegría y se sorprendieron*". Y Jesús dice: "*Ustedes son testigos de estas cosas*".


