FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR:

This Fourth Sunday of Easter is traditionally called "Good Shepherd Sunday" because the Gospel reading comes from the tenth chapter of the Gospel of St. John: Jesus uses the image of the Shepherd to refer to himself. For people of Jesus' time, the image of a shepherd would have been familiar, both as a part of their everyday experience of seeing shepherds and from the long history of shepherding images in Jewish Scriptures. The Scriptures today bring to our attention the close bond that exists between a shepherd and his sheep. The shepherd would lead the way for the sheep, whether it is in dark valleys or peaceful places. There is no place the sheep are led to, where its shepherd has not been before and has not first experienced. When the shepherd sleeps, he lays at the gate of the pen so that no sheep get out, and nothing gets in to harm the sheep. Jesus proclaims that he is **the good shepherd and sheep-gate** for his followers.

By the same token, St. John the evangelist reminds us of the great privilege to be called a child of God. He urges us not to let anyone or anything deface that image. Jesus the Good shepherd not only tends his own, but he also calls those who have not yet heard his voice and leads them safely home.

The sheep come to trust the shepherd. He knows each of his sheep and cares for each of them, and so when he calls, his sheep respond.

There is something innately a part of a Christian's soul that wants to respond to Christ. We come to trust the Shepherd when we realize that He knows each of us and cares for us, and so when Christ calls, we respond.

ADORATION OF THE MOST BLESSED SACRAMENT



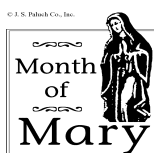

Reflexiones del Párroco:

Este Cuarto Domingo de Pascua es tradicionalmente llamado "**Domingo del Buen Pastor**" porque la lectura del Evangelio proviene del décimo capítulo del Evangelio de San Juan: Jesús utiliza la imagen del Pastor para referirse a sí mismo. Para personas de la época de Jesús, la imagen de un pastor hubiera sido familiar, tanto como parte de su experiencia cotidiana de ver pastores y de la larga historia de imágenes del pastoreo en las Escrituras Judías. Las escrituras hoy traen a nuestra atención el estrecho vínculo que existe entre un pastor y sus ovejas. El pastor guiaría el camino para las ovejas, ya sea en valles oscuros o lugares pacíficos. No hay lugar a donde las ovejas son guiadas que el pastor no ha experimentado primero. Cuando el pastor duerme, él se acuesta en la puerta del redil para que no se salga alguna oveja y nada entre a hacerles daño. Jesús proclama que **es el pastor y la puerta del redil** para sus seguidores.



Por la misma razón, San Juan el Evangelista nos recuerda del gran privilegio de ser llamados hijos de Dios. Él nos urge que no dejemos a nadie ni nada estropear esa imagen. Jesús el Buen Pastor no sólo cuida los suyos, pero también llama a quienes todavía no han escuchado su voz y los guía cuidadosamente a casa.

Las ovejas llegan a confiar en el pastor. El conoce cada una de sus ovejas y cuida de cada una, y así cuando él llama, sus ovejas responden.

Hay algo innatamente una parte de el alma de un Cristiano que quiere responderle a Cristo. Hemos llegado a confiar en el Pastor y nos hemos dado cuenta de que Él conoce a cada uno de nosotros y se preocupa por cada uno de nosotros, y así cuando Cristo llama, respondemos.

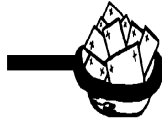
