Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

I write to you concerning an alarming and serious matter that negatively impacts the Church in the United States directly, and that strikes at the fundamental right to religious liberty for all citizens of any faith. The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services promulgated a new and radical interpretation of religious freedom last week when it announced new regulations regarding health insurance coverage of reproductive services which will be mandatory for employers in the United States.

For the first time in federal law, the government has determined that religious institutions such as Catholic hospitals, Catholic Charities and Catholic Relief Services are not truly religious employers because they do not have as their primary purpose "the inculcation of religious values" and do not primarily limit their services to those of their own faith.

In other words, the religious activities of our Catholic hospitals, our social services to the poor, and our outreach to the hurting and the marginalized in our society are not truly religious activities protected by the first amendment because they enshrine the Catholic belief -- shared by virtually every religious community in the United States -- that religious communities are called to reach out to feed the poor, shelter the homeless, and heal the sick precisely as a religious activity.

The implications of this insidious new legal and policy principle, if allowed to stand, are chilling. Once it is accepted that religious institutions that serve the poor, the sick and the elderly do not enjoy the full protections of religious liberty, future administrations could compel religious hospitals and service organization to pay for insurance and other policies that mandate abortion or euthanasia. In addition, such a principle would likely create crises of conscience for religious institutions of virtually every faith, so that over time they would be forced out of the mainstream of the social fabric.

We cannot -- we will not -- accept this unjust redrafting of the principle of religious liberty which our Founders so rightly saw as an inalienable gift of God. People of faith cannot be made second class citizens. And faith based service to those in need in our society cannot be classified as non-religious by our national government. We are already joined by our brothers and sisters of many other faiths as well as others of good will in this important effort to regain our religious freedom. Indeed, many journalists across the political spectrum, both supporters and opponents of the present administration, have called for a reversal of this policy.

Therefore, I ask for your help. Please email or write the White House and your representative in congress to call for a reversal of this new regulation. The addresses are listed on the attached sheet. Finally, please join me in prayer for our Church and for the wider religious community engaged in this struggle.

May God bless you and your family, and keep you always in His loving care.

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo:

Me dirijo a ustedes en relación a un asunto serio y alarmante que afecta directa y negativamente a la Iglesia en los Estados Unidos, y que ataca el derecho fundamental de libertad de religión de todos los ciudadanos de cualquier fe.

El Departamento de Salud y Servicios Humanos de Estados Unidos promulgó una nueva y radical interpretación de la libertad de religión la semana pasada cuando anunció nuevas regulaciones en referencia a la cobertura de seguro médico sobre servicios reproductivos que será obligatoria para todos los empleadores en los Estados Unidos.

Por primera vez en la ley federal, el gobierno ha determinado que las instituciones religiosas tales como hospitales católicos, Caridades Católicas, y los Servicios Católicos de Ayuda no son realmente empleadores católicos porque no tienen como objetivo primordial "la inculcación de valores religiosos" y que principalmente no limitan sus servicios a aquellos de su propia fe.

En otras palabras, las actividades religiosas de nuestros hospitales católicos, nuestros servicios sociales a los pobres, y nuestra ayuda a los que sufren y a los marginados en nuestra sociedad no son verdaderas actividades religiosas protegidas por la primera enmienda, ya que consagran la creencia católica - compartida por casi todas las comunidades religiosas en los Estados Unidos - que las comunidades religiosas están llamadas a alimentar a los pobres, dar albergue a los desamparados, y sanar a los enfermos, precisamente, como una actividad religiosa.

Las consecuencias de este insidioso nuevo principio jurídico y político, si se permiten, son escalofrantes. Una vez que se acepte que las instituciones religiosas que sirven a los pobres, a los enfermos y a los ancianos no gozan de todas las protecciones de la libertad religiosa, las administraciones futuras podrían obligar a hospitales religiosos y a las organizaciones de servicios a pagar el seguro y otras políticas que ordenarían el aborto o la eutanasia. Además, es probable que este principio crearía crisis de conciencia a las instituciones religiosas de casi todas las religiones, por lo que con el tiempo serían forzadas a salir de la corriente principal de la trama social.

No podemos - no debemos - aceptar esta nueva redacción injusta del principio de libertad de religión, que nuestros Fundadores vieron con razón como un don inalienable de Dios. La gente de fe no se puede convertir en ciudadano de segunda clase. Y el servicio basado en la fe a los necesitados de nuestra sociedad no puede ser clasificado como no-religioso por nuestro gobierno nacional. Ya estamos unidos a nuestros hermanos y hermanas de muchas otras religiones, así como otras personas de buena voluntad en este importante esfuerzo para recuperar nuestra libertad de religión. De hecho, muchos periodistas de todo el espectro político, tanto partidarios como opositores del actual gobierno, han llamado a una reversión de esta política.

Por lo tanto, yo les pido su ayuda. Por favor envíen un correo electrónico o escriban a la Casa Blanca y a su representante en el congreso pidiendo la reversión de esta nueva regulación. Las direcciones son mencionadas en la hoja atada. Finalmente, por favor únense a mí en oración por nuestra Iglesia y por la extensa comunidad religiosa comprometida en esta lucha.

Que Dios les bendiga a ustedes y a sus familias, y les guarde siempre bajo Su cuidado amoroso.

**ASH WEDNESDAY February 22, 2012**  
 A Day of Fast & Abstinence



**Mass Schedule is as follows:** 7:30am, 9:00am (with School Children), 12:00pm, 5:15pm and 6:30pm in Spanish.

**We will also celebrate Para-Liturgies, to bless & impose Ashes at:** 11:00 am, 2:30 pm and 4:00 pm.

**At these Masses and Para-Liturgies, Ashes will be blessed and imposed on the faithful participating in these services.**

Ash Wednesday is a day of universal Fast and Abstinence. On this day ashes are blessed and imposed on the faithful. These ashes are branches of the olive tree, or according to custom, of the palm tree or other trees, which have been blessed the previous year on Palm Sunday. The imposition of these ashes manifest an outward sign of the inward virtue of repentance. One of formulae used at the rite of imposition of these ashes is "Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel".

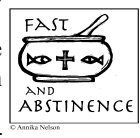
Our Parish Lenten Bulletin (available in the vestibule of the Church) is offered as a help to prepare for confession.

**GENERAL NORMS ON ABSTINENCE AND FAST**

**General Norms:** All the faithful who have made their First Communion are bound to worthily (celebrate the sacrament of reconciliation) receive Holy Communion during the Easter season.

**On Abstinence:** Everyone fourteen years of age and older is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.

**On Fast:** Everyone eighteen years of age or older but under the age of sixty is also bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On these two days, the law of fast allows only one full meal a day, but does not prohibit taking some food during the day, so long as this does not constitute another full meal. Drinking liquids during the day is permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. In doubt concerning fast or abstinence, you may consult any of the priests assigned in the parish or your confessor. In the spirit of penance, the faithful should not lightly excuse themselves from this obligation.

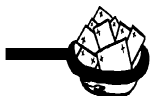
