FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR:

Today's Gospel passage is packed with exciting narratives and fast-paced action.

Finally the people who sit in darkness have seen a great light; on those dwelling in a land of overshadowed by death, light has arisen.

Jesus entered the synagogue to teach. All were amazed because he spoke with such great authority. 'He commands even the unclean spirits and they obey him'. When unclean spirit obeyed Jesus, the crowd stood in awe.

The Unclean spirits recognize Jesus as one with greater power. They confess Jesus, as "the Holy One of God", and the voice employed is plural: 'Have you come to destroy us?' In other words, the 'kingdom of Satan and the unclean spirits' is obviously threatened by the Holy presence of Jesus.

Jesus comes to establish the Kingdom of God, the kingdom of Truth, of Justice, of Peace and His righteousness. Jesus will battle the forces of evil to the death, his death, because the power of God is at work in Jesus.

The chilling words are complemented by action, for the man convulses as the unclean spirit is driven out, and then the spirit itself cries out in a loud voice. The remarks from the man, the spirit, from Jesus and from the crowd are vibrant and fascinating. The reading ends with the subtle acknowledgement of the impact of Jesus' ministry and fame.

News of his work on behalf of the sick, the possessed, and the poor is beginning to spread, and the Gospel of Mark is filled with the tension of the ever increasing spreading fame of Jesus' good works and his desire for solitude, prayer and silence.

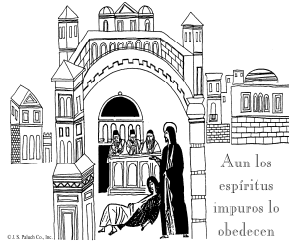

El pasaje del Evangelio de hoy está lleno de narrativos emocionantes y acción rápida. Finalmente, las personas que se sientan en la oscuridad han visto una gran luz; en aquellos viviendo en una tierra ensombrecida por la muerte, ha surgido la luz.



Jesús entró a la sinagoga para enseñar. Todos estaban asombrados porque habló con gran autoridad. **'Este hombre tiene autoridad para mandar hasta los espíritus inmundos y lo obedecen'**. Cuando el espíritu Inmundo obedeció a Jesús, la multitud se asombró.

El espíritu Inmundo reconoce a Jesús como uno con mayor poder. Confiesa a Jesús, como "el Sagrado de Dios", y la voz que emplea es plural: '¿Has venido a destruirnos?'

Jesús le dará batalla a las fuerzas del mal a la muerte, su muerte, porque el poder de Dios está obrando en Jesús.

Las palabras escalofriantes son complementadas por acción, que el hombre es sacudido conforme el espíritu inmundo es expulsado y, a continuación, el propio espíritu clama en voz alta.
