FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR:

Prophet Amos is probably one of the best-known prophets. Prior to his calling to prophesy in Israel, he was a peaceful, simple, ordinary common poor shepherd taking care of his flock in Judah. God commissions him to shepherd Israel in one of the most difficult times of national disintegration and humiliation. It is a time of crisis not only for the prophet personally, but also ... a heightened moment of fragmentation, disintegration, of God's Chosen People:

The twelve tribes of Israel were divided into two kingdoms – Israel in the north and Judah in the south. The temple of Jerusalem was in the south. The northern kings did not want their people to go to Jerusalem and so they built a rival temple at Bethel. The kings appointed priests and prophets, and since they were on the payroll of the kings, they preached what tickled the ears of the kings.

Amos is not hired by anyone, rather, is called and commissioned by Yahweh to a prophetic ministry, to speak the authentic Word of God, and convey God's will, with the responsibility of Eternal Salvation of the people entrusted to his care. Amos does just that till he is expelled from the northern kingdom.

Jesus sends the twelve apostles to preach repentance, heal the sick and drive out demons. Perhaps this was not what the disciples signed up for, when they left their fishing nets and customs post. They expected a Messiah to be powerful enough to free Israel from foreign domination. As followers of such a mighty king, they did not expect to find themselves out on the road without food, money, an extra coat....

In much the same manner, we open the door with one 'yes', which leads to another and another. Often we find ourselves in a place we never intended to go and often in a task we thought beyond us....

Our God of surprises does not reveal his plan to us all at once, does he? Psalm 119:105 says, "A lamp to my feet is your Word, a Light to my path." God reveals his plan step by step.

As of date we have received \$ 28,073.00 in cash, checks & credit cards, \$ 2,995.00 in the form of pledges amounting to a total of \$ 31,068.00 which is 61.04% of our goal. The Balance we owe is \$ 19,832.00

The Parish Finance Committee has recommended we take up a second collection on the First Sunday of every month beginning June 2012, in order to make this goal.

Reflexiones del Párroco:

Profeta Amos es probablemente uno de los profetas más conocidos. Antes de su llamado a profetizar en Israel, era un pastor pacífico, sencillo, común y corriente, cuidador de su rebaño en Judá. Dios le encarga a profetizar a Israel en uno de los momentos más difíciles de la desintegración nacional y humillación. Es un momento de crisis no sólo para el profeta personalmente, pero también... un momento de alta fragmentación, desintegración, del pueblo elegido de Dios:

Las doce tribus de Israel se dividieron en dos reinos: Israel al norte y Judá en el sur. El templo de Jerusalén estaba en el sur. Los Reyes del Norte no querían que su pueblo se fuera a Jerusalén y así construyeron un templo rival en Betel. Los Reyes nombraron a sacerdotes y profetas, y como estaban bajo la nómina de los Reyes, predicaban lo que les hacía cosquilla a los oídos de los Reyes.

Amos no es contratado por nadie, más bien, es llamado y comisionado por Yahweh a un ministerio profético para hablar la auténtica Palabra de Dios y transmitir el deseo de Dios, con la responsabilidad de la Salvación Eterna del pueblo encomendado a su cuidado. Amos hace justamente eso, hasta que es expulsado del Reino del Norte.

Jesús envía a los doce apóstoles a predicar arrepentimiento, a sanar los enfermos y expulsar demonios. Quizás esto no fue para lo que se inscribieron los discípulos, cuando dejaron sus redes de pesca y costumbres. Esperaban a un Mesías ser lo suficientemente poderoso como para liberar a Israel de la dominación extranjera. Como seguidores de un Rey tan poderoso, no esperaban encontrarse en la jornada sin alimento, dinero, una capa extra....

De la misma manera, abrimos la puerta con un 'sí', que conduce a otro y otro. A menudo nos encontramos en un lugar al que nunca pretendíamos estar y a menudo en una tarea que pensamos más allá de nosotros....

¿Nuestro Dios de sorpresas no revela su plan a nosotros toda a la vez, o sí? Salmo 119:105 dice, "Una lámpara a mis pies es tu Palabra, una Luz en mi camino." Dios revela su plan paso a paso.

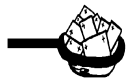
