FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR:



In today's First reading Nathan reminds King David how God in his gracious kindness chose him, and established him as the King of Israel. Nathan's perfectly crafted parable challenges David's understanding of justice and integrity. David acknowledges his sin against God and His people. David realizes how he not only committed a grave sin against Uriah but also compounded the crime with an attempt to cover-up: engineering the death of Uriah in a cold-blooded murder. David repents his deplorable scandalous sins, and vows in his humble contrite spirit to make amends. God forgives him. However, the reading suggests that there would be consequences to come.

In the Gospel, Jesus forgives a woman who expresses great love by washing his feet with her tears.

It appears that this woman had previously encountered Jesus and had received his forgiveness. She made brave & extravagant gestures: She kissed and anointed the feet of a reclining Jesus, to the evident scandal of Simon, his Pharisee host.

Simon, the host reasons out that if Jesus was a prophet, then he would have known who it is who is touching him now and not risk being rendered unclean. Jesus, on the other hand accepted her presence and her ministering with gentle courtesy. His verdict is clear to the point: 'Her great love proves that her sins have been forgiven'.

Simon, the host, had invited Jesus to his house. He was cold, hollow and formal in the reception of his guest. He omitted those gestures of esteem and affection with which an honored guest was expected to be received. Whereas, the poor woman prodigally supplied them. She was invested in this encounter.

In the parable 'Love' means 'thankful love', or 'gratitude'. And so the question Jesus puts before them is: "Which of them is more grateful,?"

What Simon is being told is the application of the parable: This woman, despite her sinful past, is nearer to God than Simon, for she has something, she possesses something, what Simon lacks: 'gratitude'.

ARCHBISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL OF 2013

Each year our Archbishop requests our help to support him to operate the central Archdiocesan offices in order to coordinate and administrate resources for various parishes in the Archdiocese. The cost of this endeavor is distributed among parishes in our three counties of San Mateo, San Francisco and Marin. Our share of the cost this new year is \$ 48,100.00.

As of date we have received \$ 22,535.00 in cash, checks & credit cards, \$ 1,370.00 in the form of pledges amounting to a total of \$ 23,905.00 which is 49.70% of our goal. The Balance we owe is \$ 24,195.00.

The Parish Finance Committee has recommended we take up a second collection on the First Sunday of every month beginning June 2013, in order to make this goal.

FATHER'S DAY

Being a Catholic dad is both a great privilege and a big responsibility. With their wives and so both of them together, God has espoused to them the loving charge of His children, to raise them up, to know, to love and to serve God and our neighbor, and so prepare them for lives as Catholic men and women. This Father's Day becomes a day of renewal of our calling to our precious vocation as Fathers. Therefore, how about if we try to:

Keep Holy the Lord's Day and all those other days... (Exodus 20:8): Fatherhood is the ultimate exercise in getting priorities right. Our children are always watching us when we do things wrong.. but the good news is that they are also watching us when we do things right!

Teach Your Children Faith...(John 20:29): Faith is best learnt by example. It requires a lot of surrender, humility and also exercise of authentic authority.

Make efforts to Forgive and be forgiven...(Matthew 18:21-22): The Sacrament of Reconciliation is a uniquely Catholic ritual: while it teaches us accountability, it also reminds us of God's bottomless well of forgiveness,..... the beginnings of many great lessons to teach our children who learn from this responsibility. It requires us to admit our failures and children watching us learn to ask for forgiveness when they mess up, and know that they can be forgiven.

Give and Let Give: (Proverbs 28:27) An old expression says: "When there is a piano to be moved, don't reach for the stool." Generosity is a value of great sacrifice. It comes from a noble heart.

Play and Have Fun...(Luke 18:16-17) Our life on earth is short and the lease of time with our children from the day they are born till they are big enough to leave home is brief... and so if we do not play and have fun now, we may never have another right time to do the same.

Get Caught Praying... (Luke 11:1) Let our children watch us praying, and find us in prayer, to encourage them to pray with gratitude, thanking God for so many blessings, and directing them to pray over meals, at bedtime, at rising. Praying the Rosary is a pretty intimate act.

Let it Shine, Let it Shine, Let it Shine.... (Matthew 5:14-16) to inspire, evoke, encourage, cultivate, enable and ennoble, the little angels God so lovingly entrusted to your care, so that those talents may bloom and mature for the greater glory of God.

Reflexiones del Párroco:



En la Primera lectura de hoy Natán le recuerda al Rey David cómo Dios en su bondad amable lo escogió a él y lo consagró como el Rey de Israel. La parábola perfectamente hecha a mano por Natán reta la comprensión de David de la justicia y la integridad. David reconoce su pecado contra Dios y su pueblo. David se da cuenta de cómo no sólo cometió un pecado grave contra Urías pero también agrava el delito con un intento de encubrimiento: la muerte de Urías en un asesinato a sangre fría. David se arrepiente de sus pecados escandalosos deplorables y se compromete humildemente en espíritu conrto a hacer las paces. Dios lo perdona. Sin embargo, la lectura sugiere que habrá consecuencias por venir. En el Evangelio, Jesús perdona a una mujer que expresa gran amor lavando sus pies con sus lágrimas.

Parece que esta mujer había encontrado previamente a Jesús y había recibido su perdón. Ella hizo gestos extravagantes y valientes: ella besó y ungió los pies de un Jesús reclinado, al escándalo evidente de Simón, su anfitrión Fariseo.

Simón, el anfitrión razonó que si Jesús era un Profeta, entonces él hubiera sabido quién era quien lo tocaba ahora y no se hubiese arriesgado a ser rendido impuro. Jesús, por el contrario aceptó su presencia y su ministerio con cortesía suave. Su veredicto es claro al punto: 'Su gran amor demuestra que sus pecados han sido perdonados'.

Simón, el anfitrión, había invitado a Jesús a su casa. El fue frío, hueco y formal en la recepción de su huésped. Omitió aquellos gestos de aprecio y cariño con el que un invitado de honor espera ser recibido. Mientras que la pobre mujer pródiga lo suministra. Estaba dedicada a este encuentro.

En la parábola 'Amor' significa 'amor agradecido' o 'gratitud'. ¿Así la pregunta que Jesús pone delante de ellos es: '¿Cual de ellos es más agradecido?'

Lo que se le está diciendo a Simón es la aplicación de la parábola: Esta mujer, a pesar de su pasado pecaminoso, está más cerca de Dios que Simón, por que ella tiene algo, ella posee algo, que carece Simón: 'gratitud'.
