FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR:

The Book of Chronicles gives us a brief history of the people of Israel. The first reading today tells us about the people who lived in sin, mocking God's messengers and ignoring the Lord's warnings. They turned their backs on God. They disowned God. Their pride and egotism put themselves in vulnerable religious and political situations. Finally, their enemies destroyed Jerusalem. The people were taken captive resulting into a national disaster. However, God does not abandon them. It is again God's mercy that delivers them from slavery and misery.



John 3:16 is one of the most well-known sentences from the lips of Jesus in the whole of the New Testament: "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life". The entire reading is the discourse between Jesus and Nicodemus, helping one to reflect on the testimony of God's love for the salvation of all. St. Paul reminds us that it is by his grace that we have been saved. It is always the power of God that saves and promises hope even in moments of doubt and despair. He says that we are his handiwork, created in Christ Jesus for the good works that God has prepared for us. Thus we are God's creation, gifted by God's grace, and from this will flow the good works with which we thank God and contribute to the well-being of the Church, society and the world.

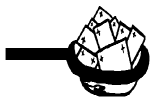
