QUINCEAÑERAS

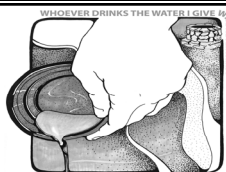

FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR:



On this Third Sunday of Lent we begin a three-week series of Gospel readings from St. John. These texts have been historically associated with Christian initiation. The three great stories of the woman at the well, the man born blind, and Lazarus are intimately associated with pre-baptismal catechesis for those preparing to be initiated at the Easter Vigil.

For those of us, who are already baptized, the readings continue to offer an equally important opportunity to explore the meaning of our own Christian initiation: our commitment and life of discipleship.

Today's the flowing of water in the Exodus story speaks of a saving God who has rescued us even in the midst of our grumbling, hardness of heart, and lack of trust. St. Paul in the second reading today speaks of the love of God that has been 'poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit'. Jesus in the Gospel offers to the woman and to all who hear the gospel, the gift of Living Water – Himself, and the divine love that He embodies.

The Johanne narratives are carefully constructed presentations meant to strike a spark of recognition in every listener. The turning point in the story is when Jesus shocks the woman by disclosing that he knows facts about her personal life that no ordinary person could know. The woman is mortified by what Jesus says about her life. The subtle dramatic effect is geared to help us see ourselves in the interaction between Jesus and the Samaritan woman. This leads the woman to recognize that Jesus must be a prophet; The conversation that follows open her eyes to see that Jesus is the Messiah. The woman lets go of her self-deception, and once that happens, she finds herself filled with the possibilities of the new Eternal Life.

He redefines everything anew. His love, his invitation, his offer of healing forgiveness – all of these are recounted in the hope that we will understand more deeply what it means to be given the gift of living water in baptism.

Our Parish Lenten Bulletin (available in the vestibule of the Church) is offered as a help to prepare for confession.

GENERAL NORMS—ABSTINENCE

General Norms: All the faithful who have made their First Holy Communion are bound to worthily (celebrate the sacrament of reconciliation) and receive Holy Communion during the Easter season.

On Abstinence: Everyone fourteen years of age and older is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.

Reflexiones del Párroco:

En este Tercer Domingo de Cuaresma iniciamos una serie de tres semanas de lecturas del Evangelio de San Juan. Estos textos han sido históricamente asociados con la iniciación Cristiana. Las tres grandes historias de la mujer en el pozo, el hombre nacido ciego y Lázaro están íntimamente asociadas con la catequesis prebautismal para aquellos preparándose para ser iniciados en la Vigilia de Pascua.

Para quienes ya están bautizados, las lecturas continúan ofreciendo una oportunidad importante de explorar el significado de nuestra propia iniciación Cristiana: nuestro compromiso y vida de discipulado.

Hoy, el flujo de agua en la historia de Éxodo habla de un Dios salvador quien nos ha rescatado incluso en medio de nuestras murmuraciones, dureza de corazón y falta de confianza. San Pablo en la segunda lectura de hoy habla del amor de Dios que ha sido 'derramado en nuestros corazones a través del Espíritu Santo'. Jesús en el Evangelio le ofrece a la mujer y a todos quienes escuchan el Evangelio, el don de la Agua Viva – a Sí Mismo, y el amor divino que Él encarna.

Las descripciones de Juan son presentaciones cuidadosamente construidas para lograr una chispa de reconocimiento en cada oyente. El punto de inflexión en la historia es cuando Jesús asusta a la mujer revelándole que Él conoce hechos sobre su vida personal que ninguna persona ordinaria podría saber. La mujer es mortificada por lo que Jesús dice acerca de su vida. El sutil efecto dramático es orientado para ayudar a vernos a sí mismos en la interacción entre Jesús y la mujer Samaritana. Esto llevó a la mujer a reconocer que Jesús debe ser un profeta; La conversación que sigue le abre sus ojos para ver que Jesús es el Mesías. La mujer deja ir su autoengaño, y en cuanto esto pasa, se encuentra llena de las posibilidades de la nueva Vida Eterna.

Él redefine todo nuevamente. Su amor, Su invitación, Su oferta de sanación en el perdón: todos estos son relacionados con la esperanza que entendamos más profundamente lo que significa ser dado el don de la agua viva en el bautismo.

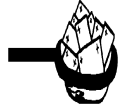
