FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR:

In popular religion of all times the misfortune befalling people can come to be looked on as divine chastisement for personal sins. It is after all but a short step from the belief that God punishes sin to a consideration of the accidents, mishaps, and so on that befall a person as penalties directly inflicted by God. Today's reading tells us how Jesus was once asked a question on the subject. The Tower of Siloam had collapsed at that time. Jesus' reply is that the mishaps that befall people are no indication at all that they are sinners. Yet it is equally true, he says, that sin calls for repentance. In declaring 'unless you repent, you will all perish just as they did,' Jesus primarily addressed the Jewish nation which was increasingly growing to reject Him. Unless they repent of this, He tells them, they will be excluded from the promises and lose them. The kingdom will be taken away from them and given to the Gentiles; the nation will end in revolt and Jerusalem in ruins. The parable of the barren fig tree teaches the same message: The tree had reached the fruit-bearing age, but it remained unfruitful. The owner of the vineyard felt it should be cut down. The vinedresser appealed on behalf of the tree and pleaded for time; he would make the last desperate effort to save the tree. The fig tree symbolizes Israel, and as in the book of Jeremiah, the sterile Israel. Now the ax is laid to the root of the tree. This is the last chance. If Israel does not bring forth the fruits of repentance, the time of grace will have run out. The theme this weekend is the "urgency of the hour". Not to lose this moment of opportunity to repent and come back to God.

THE RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Following the 'Rite of Election' weeks ago, unbaptized adults and older children who are preparing for Christian initiation at the Easter Vigil are referred to as "the Elect". On the Third, Fourth and Fifth Sundays of Lent, rites known as "Scrutinies" are celebrated with the elect following the homily at Mass.

The Scrutinies "are rites for self-searching and repentance... (and) are meant to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect; to bring forth, then strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good". (RCIA 141)

This weekend, those preparing to enter the Church at Easter, will celebrate their first scrutiny. They will receive the gift of 'the Creed' of the Catholic Church. Please pray that they may find the Creed of the Church, the sustenance to live life to its fullest.

Reflexiones del Párroco:

En la religiosidad popular de todos los tiempos la desgracia ocurrida a personas puede venir a ser mirada como castigo divino por pecados personales. Es después de todo sólo un pequeño paso de la creencia de que Dios castiga el pecado a una consideración de los accidentes, percances y así sucesivamente que le suceda a una persona como penas infligidas directamente por Dios. La lectura de hoy nos cuenta cómo Jesús fue una vez preguntado sobre el tema. La torre de Siloé se había derrumbado en aquel tiempo. La respuesta de Jesús es que los percances que le ocurren a las personas no son ninguna indicación de que ellos son pecadores. Pero es igualmente cierto, dice, que el pecado pide arrepentimiento. Al declarar que 'al menos que se arrepientan, todos perecerán así como ellos', Jesús se dirigió principalmente a la nación Judía que crecía cada vez más a rechazarlo. Al menos de que se arrepientan de esto, Él les dice, que serán excluidos de las promesas y los perderán. Se les arrancara el Reino de con ellos y dado a los Gentiles; la nación terminará en una rebelión y Jerusalén en ruinas. La parábola de la higuera estéril enseña el mismo mensaje: el árbol había llegado a la edad de frutales, pero seguía siendo infértil. El dueño de la Viña sintió que debe cortarse. El viñador hizo un llamamiento en nombre del árbol y pidió tiempo; él haría el último esfuerzo desesperado para salvar el árbol. La higuera simboliza a Israel y como en el libro de Jeremías, el estéril Israel. Ahora se coloca el hacha en la raíz del árbol. Esta es la última oportunidad. Si Israel no produce los frutos de arrepentimiento, habrán agotado el tiempo de gracia. El tema de este fin de semana es la "urgencia de la hora". De no perder este momento una oportunidad para arrepentirse y volver a Dios.
