FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR:

Today's Gospel story of the Prodigal son is one of the most famous of Jesus' parables. It is at times also called the parable of two brothers. Brothers, just like you and me! St. Luke presents a portrait of God's gracious love and two negative responses to that love. Both sons, in their own ways, indicate the disposition of a soul in estrangement from God!

This tragic estrangement is a turning away from God. It is an obstinate refusal to appreciate God's providential loving care. It furthermore, drowns us in the pit of selfishness, egotism and pride.

- Have we smugly demanded what we think is ours and selfishly left others behind?
- Or are we, like the older brother, self-righteous?
- Do we stand outside the banquet because we do not like the rules?
- Are our attempts at righteousness misguided?

The father does not ask much for the riches he generously bestows upon his prodigal son. He gives and continues to give of himself freely, with joy. His repentant son, coming back to 'senses' is now willing to appreciate and gratefully acknowledge and accept the gifts that the father has offered all along, though now with a more correct sense of his relationship to the father. Best robe, signet ring, shoes: the youth is re-instated. He is 'son' as though he had never left, had never gone astray. Nor is this the end. This is a moment to be savored.

The older brother is left at the story's end, standing outside the banquet hall with a choice on his hands: Will he set his pride aside and enjoy the father's boundless love? Or will he continue, alone, to brood over his self-righteousness and to call the shots?

The story of the father and his two sons is an allegory; the characters are God, public sinner and the self-righteous. Jesus' purpose was not only to highlight God's gracious forgiveness. It was also to hold the mirror up to the self-righteous opponents. It was to challenge them to see themselves in the older son. This Gospel challenges each of us to do the same.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Today, "Laetare Sunday," breaks the somberness of Lent for a little rejoicing, and the readings all summon us to an awareness of reconciliation. One of the best-loved stories of our tradition is today's Gospel story of the runaway son and the prodigal father. Prodigal, of course, is an adjective meaning "spendthrift or extravagant to a degree bordering on recklessness," and although the boy maxes out the credit cards, it is really the father who is prodigal with forgiveness.

Part of the excitement of this Laetare Sunday is rooted in the ancient catechumenate. Long ago, midway through Lent, the "elect" were focusing more and more on the gift of reconciliation accomplished for them by Christ and about to be realized in the Easter sacraments they were preparing to celebrate. In some places, the elect were even bedecked with roses on this day. A person bedecked with roses sticks out in a crowd; a person formed by the Eucharist and committed to living a life of reconciliation does, too. That's you!

Reflexiones del Párroco:

La historia del Evangelio de hoy del hijo Pródigo es una de las más famosas de las parábolas de Jesús. Es a veces llamada también la parábola de los dos hermanos. Hermanos, al igual que usted y yo!



San Lucas presenta un retrato del amor misericordioso de Dios y dos respuestas negativas a ese amor. Ambos hijos, a su manera, indican la disposición del alma en el alejamiento de Dios!

Este distanciamiento trágico es un alejamiento a Dios. Es una negativa obstinada a apreciar el cuidado amoroso providencial de Dios. Además, nos ahoga en la boca del egoísmo, el egotismo y el orgullo.

- ¿Hemos exigido con engreimiento lo que creemos que es nuestro y egoístamente dejado a otros atrás?
- ¿O somos nosotros, como el hermano mayor, moralistas?
- ¿Nos quedamos de pie afuera del banquete porque no nos gustan las reglas?
- ¿Son nuestros intentos de justicia equivocadas?

El padre no pide mucho por las riquezas que otorga a su hijo pródigo. El da y sigue dando de sí mismo libremente, con alegría. Su hijo arrepentido, volviendo al 'sentido' está ahora dispuesto a apreciar y reconocer agradecidamente y aceptar los dones que el padre ha ofrecido todo el tiempo, aunque ahora con un sentido más correcto de su relación con el padre. Mejor traje, anillo de sello, zapatos: la juventud es reinstalada. El es 'hijo' como si nunca se hubiese ido, nunca se hubiese ido por mal camino. Tampoco es el fin. Este es un momento para ser saboreada.

¿El hermano mayor quedó al final de la historia, de pie afuera de la sala de banquetes con una opción en sus manos: Pondrá su orgullo a un lado y disfrutar del amor ilimitado del padre? ¿O continuará solo para darle vueltas a su moralismo y tener la última palabra?

La historia del padre y sus dos hijos es alegoría; los personajes son Dios, pecador publico y el moralista. El propósito de Jesús no era sólo de resaltar el perdón misericordioso de Dios. También era para sostener el espejo a los opositores moralistas. Era para retarlos a verse a sí mismos en el hijo mayor. Este evangelio reta a cada uno de nosotros a hacer lo mismo.
