FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR:

Today's scriptures offer an incentive to be prepared for the return of the Lord, whenever He may come. Being watchful is part of this on-going preparation, because we do not know when and even how the Lord will come. If we wait watchfully, we wait worthily.

The parable of the ten virgins is told against the background of Palestinian wedding customs. Several features of the parable manifest its end-of-time character: The banquet itself and its context of waiting in darkness for this solemn moment to arrive and the much anticipated event to occur, without knowing exactly when it will come to pass. The virgins differ from one another precisely in terms of their preparedness. Half of the virgins made provision for the possible delay of the bridegroom, the other half did not.

This parable highlights the transition from the present times to the time of fulfillment. The bottom line is: one is either ready to cross that threshold or one is not. Jesus exhorts at the end of the parable to 'be alert'.

We like to think of Jesus as the Lord of second chances, even third and fourth, and that we have plenty of time to get our act together and to gather the necessary "oil" to welcome him when he returns. But the bridegroom's final words are, "I do not know you."

This parable prompts us to reflect on some questions similar to these:

Is Jesus indicating that a day will come when that opportunity to make up for what we have failed to do will not be given? That the time for springing into action will have come and gone?

Could we end up finding ourselves locked out of the party?

What are we putting off doing?.....

**Reflexiones del Párroco:**

Las Escrituras de hoy ofrecen un incentivo para prepararse para el regreso del Señor, para cuando pueda venir. Estar al pendiente es parte de esta preparación en curso, porque no sabemos aún cómo ni cuándo vendrá el Señor. Si esperamos con vigilia, esperamos dignamente.



La parábola de las diez vírgenes es narrada al trasfondo de las costumbres de las bodas Palestinas. Varias características de la parábola manifiestan su carácter de final de los tiempos: El banquete en sí y su contexto de espera en la oscuridad para que este momento solemne llegue y el evento tan anticipado en pasar, sin saber exactamente cuándo llegará a pasar. Las Vírgenes difieren entre sí precisamente en términos de su preparación. La mitad de las Vírgenes prevén el posible retraso del novio, la otra mitad no.

Esta parábola destaca la transición de los tiempos presentes al tiempo de cumplimiento. La conclusión es: uno está listo para cruzar ese umbral o no lo está. Jesús exhorta al final de la parábola que debemos "estar alertos".

Nos gusta pensar en Jesús como el Señor de segundas oportunidades, hasta tercera y cuarta, y que tenemos mucho tiempo para ponernos al tanto y reunir el "petróleo" necesario para darle la bienvenida cuando Él regrese. Pero son las palabras finales del novio, "no te conozco".

Esta parábola nos lleva a reflexionar sobre algunas preguntas similares a éstas:

- ¿Está Jesús indicando que el día llegará cuando esa oportunidad de compensar por lo que hemos fallado en hacer no será dado?
- ¿Que el tiempo para ponerse en acción habrá llegado y pasado?
- ¿Podríamos terminar encontrándonos fuera del banquete?
- ¿Qué estamos posponiendo hacer?.....

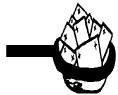
