MINISTRY TO THE SICK & HOMEBOUND

Call the parish office to make arrangements to administer this sacrament for one who is sick or homebound or in the hospital. 

FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR:

This Sunday the theme revolves around banquets and celebrations. In the book of Isaiah we learn how all people will be invited to the banquet, not just the chosen ones. We are given a glimpse of the day God has planned for us: It will be the end of all hurt, suffering, and sadness we have known. St. Paul assures the Philippians, that their every need will be satisfied. St. Matthew recounts Jesus' parable of a wedding banquet, inviting us to God's eternal feast. In the parable the response from those invited first, is marked with apathy, and indifference, which prompts God to invite anyone who wants to come!

However, there is a dress code, a lifestyle, an attitude of heart and mind, etc., symbolized in wearing or not wearing the "wedding garment". In the parable, one person (from the second group) came to the feast not wearing the traditional wedding garment. He remained silent when questioned. He could have made excuses: he did not have much notice; he came after all, when the original one did not; How important is it really?

We accepted God's invitation to be part of the family celebration. Perhaps our parents accepted it for us at our baptism, but we have sacramentally and prayerfully confirmed that acceptance. In the garments of our baptism we have R.S.V.P.'d to the conditions of the banquet and want to be a part of this victorious celebration.

As of date we have received \$ 36,285.00 in cash, checks & credit cards, \$ 2,410.00 in the form of pledges amounting to a total of \$ 38,695.00 which is 69.35% of our goal. The Balance we owe is \$ 17,105.00.

The Parish Finance Committee has recommended that we take up a second collection on the First Sunday of every month beginning June 2011, in order to make this goal.

Este Domingo, el tema gira en torno a banquetes y celebraciones. En el libro de Isaías aprendemos cómo todas las personas se invitarán al banquete, no sólo los elegidos. Se nos da una mirada del día que Dios ha planeado para nosotros:

será el final de todo daño, sufrimiento, y tristeza que hemos conocido. San Pablo le asegura a los Filipenses, que todas sus necesidades quedarán satisfechas. San Mateo relata la parábola de Jesús de un banquete de boda, invitándonos al banquete eterno de Dios. En la parábola la respuesta de los primeros invitados, está marcada con indiferencia, que induje a Dios a invitar a quien quisiera venir!

Sin embargo, existe un código de vestimenta, un estilo de vida, una actitud de corazón y mente, etc., simbolizado en llevar o no llevar la "vestimenta de boda". En la parábola, una persona (del segundo grupo) llegó a la fiesta y no llevaba el vestuario tradicional de boda. Se mantuvo en silencio cuando se le preguntó. Él podría haber hecho excusas: no se le dió mucho aviso; después de todo, llegó cuando el original no lo hizo; ¿Qué tan importante es realmente?

Aceptamos la invitación de Dios a ser parte de la celebración familiar. Tal vez nuestros padres aceptaron para nosotros en nuestro bautismo, pero lo hemos confirmado sacramentalmente y con oración esa aceptación.
