FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR:

We are very much influenced by what others think and say about us. We all like to be well thought of by others. We may end up making popularity the goal of our lives. And we might forget the only thing that matters is the reality of who and what I am. No matter what others may think of me, God thinks well of me, because I am his loving child. Each of us can say that. However, as his child, I am expected to do his will:

Our First reading today talks about the sufferings of the just man whose task is to teach people the ways of God. He is sustained in all his trials by the firm belief that God is with him.

Even though St. Peter declared his belief in Jesus as the Messiah, he perhaps had no idea what that implied. Peter obviously believed the popular ideas about the Messiah. But Jesus had no intention of living up to that political popular expectation. If he had done so, he could have enjoyed immense popularity, fame and acclaim. But he would not have been true to his calling. He would have betrayed the mission his Father had given him.

The single-mindedness of Jesus, his fidelity, defeats all attempts to give in to temptation, even that of St. Peter. Nothing deters him from doing the will of God the Father, even though that will disappoint a lot of people, lead him into trouble and even death on the Cross.

This losing of one's own life, dying to one's false self built on the esteem of others who lure us into playing a false role, leads one into "saving one's life"... finding one's true self, to do the Will of God the Father.

ARCHBISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL of 2012

Each year our Archbishop requests our help to support him to operate the central Archdiocesan offices in order to coordinate and administrate resources for various parishes in the Archdiocese. The cost of this endeavor is distributed among parishes in our three counties of San Mateo, San Francisco and Marin. Our share of the cost this new year is \$ 50,900.00.

As of date we have received \$ 33,066.15 in cash, checks & credit cards, \$ 4,495.00 in the form of pledges amounting to a total of \$ 37,561.15 which is 73.79% of our goal. The Balance we owe is \$ 13,338.85.

The Parish Finance Committee has recommended we take up a second collection on the First Sunday of every month beginning June 2012, in order to make this goal.

Y podríamos olvidarnos de que lo único que importa es la realidad de quien soy y que soy. No importa lo que otros piensen de mí, Dios piensa bien de mí, porque yo soy su hijo amoroso. Cada uno de nosotros podemos decir eso. Sin embargo, como su hijo, se espera que haga Su voluntad:

Nuestra primera lectura de hoy habla del sufrimiento del hombre justo cuya tarea es enseñarle a la gente los caminos de Dios. El se mantiene en todos sus retos por la firme creencia de que Dios está con él.

A pesar de que San Pedro declaró su creencia en Jesús como el Mesías, tal vez no tenía idea de lo que eso implicaba. Pedro obviamente creía las ideas populares sobre el Mesías. Pero Jesús no tenía ninguna intención de cumplir con esa expectativa popular política. Si él lo hubiese hecho, el podría haber disfrutado popularidad, fama y aclamación inmensa.
