

ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL POLICIES

Supervision is provided only 10 minutes before and after the classes. The care and safety of our children is very important. From that standpoint, we invite the parents of the enrolled children into the program to partner with us towards that goal. Children should not arrive earlier than 10 minutes before scheduled classes. At the end of the classes your child should not have to wait more than 10 minutes after being dismissed.

The Religious Education classes (weather permitting) begin with a general Common Prayer Assembly in the upper grounds in front of the All Souls School. The Prayer begins on time. If the weather is not conducive, the students walk up to the class rooms with their teacher.

Following the Prayer, the participating children and their parents are addressed should there be any need for an important announcement or upcoming events.

Once the children are led to their classrooms, the outside doors and all access to the school building are closed and secured. The safety and wellbeing of our children is always our primary goal once they are under our supervision. We urge parents to extend their help and offer to help us out in this endeavor.
